## E.S. Prior and the Arts and Crafts Movement

It was Prior's conviction, as a luminary of the arts and crafts movement, that architecture should be guided by a simple design logic and the celebration of materials and workmanship. Lynne will talk us through the development of the theory, design movement and personalities that came together to construct one of the architecturally most interesting and successful churches of its date in England.

### Lecturer: Dr Lynne Walker

**Biography:** *Lynne Walker is a Senior Research Fellow at the Institute of Historical Research, London, an Honorary Fellow of the Royal Institute of British Architects and sits on the editorial advisory board of The Bloomsbury Global Encyclopaedia of Women in Architecture, 1960-2015. Following an undergraduate degree in Art History in the USA she developed an interest in Architectural History from reading Pevsner. This led to a PhD supervised by Pevsner at Birkbeck. Lynne has a great affection for the north east having taught at Northumbria University in the 1980s, collaborating with Tom Faulkner and Peter Willis.*


